All Amateurs should note that due to changes the FCC has made to its licensing system, starting on June 29, 2021, all licensees and candidates must supply the FCC with an email address on all applications. If no email address is included, the FCC may dismiss the application as “defective.”

New applicants for licenses without Federal Registration Numbers, must obtain an FRN before the examination and provide that number to the VE on Form 605 license application.

Another FCC requirement recently imposed is the addition of a \$35 fee be added to license applications. The start date for the new fee has yet to be announced.
