

CARC Meeting Notes – October 28, 2021

President Larry called the October, 2021 Zoom meeting of CARC to order at 7:31pm, with seven members and one visitor attending. After a roll call, the Minutes of the September, 2021 Zoom meeting were read, with approval, followed by the Treasurer's Report.

Larry welcomed Connor DiPietro, who joined the Zoom meeting for the first time, who is working with Tom Schwartz to get started on the path to becoming a Ham and an active member of CARC.

An election of Officers for the 2022-2023 Club year was held, and all existing office holders agreed to serve during the coming year, with the special consideration that Jim Williams' has requested that be replaced as Club Treasurer as soon as possible because of his medical problems.

The annual Club dinner in November, normally the week following Thanksgiving was briefly discussed. After Larry suggested that it might be held the weekend of December 2nd, several members reported conflicts with the date and time. The final decision was to schedule a luncheon, rather than a dinner, and that be held on Saturday, December 11th at 11:30 at Danny's Barbeque Restaurant on Tryon Street in Cary.

Larry revealed that he would not be attending the JARSFest in Benson, NC on November 21, 2021, but would rent a table if someone would volunteer to sell surplus equipment owned by the club. Tom Schwartz agreed to attend the Benson JARSFest and to display any equipment to be sold. Jay Mulik announced plans to join Tom in Benson. Others wishing to attend and or sell hardware would be welcome to share the table.

Larry announced that the Club next meeting this would occur next year, on January 27, 2022.. . Anyone with suggestions for programs was encouraged to speak up.

Jim Williams presented an excellent video program on "Wire Antennas," featuring many novel and effective versions of dipole and end-fed antennas that would assure maximum radiation in multiple configurations.
